SECTION I

ADMINISTRATION

# CHRCHOLOGICAL HARRATTYE.

The 3rd Bosbardment Group (L) was stationed for the greater part of the month of December at AFC 72, Leyte Island in the Philippines. The last week of the month the Group moved from Leyte to San Jose, Mindoro Island of the Philippines, AFC 321. It was composed of Group Headquarters and four bombardment Squadrons; the 3th, 13th, 89th and 90th. The Group consisted of 197 officers and 1007 enlisted men on the first day of December and at the ending of themonth there were 191 officers and 1081 enlisted men; a decrease of six officers and six enlisted men (1).

Leyte Island in December is starting its rainy season and during the month there as a total of 26-30 inches of rain fell. The roads were a sea of liquid mud and transportation problems were very great. The Group was located on the beach and most of the rain was absorbed in the sand and therefore did not suffer with the mud. The strips were impossible to keep up and our A-30s were unable to come up from Mollandia. During the time they were in Mollandia no missions were flown but maintenance and training was carried out. There was very little activity within the group for the entire month until the beginning of the move to Mindoro Island.

The Group commander is Colonel John F. Henebry, Operations officer is Major Bruce Marston and the deputy commander is Major Charles Move, Capt. Ivan Head is Intelligence officer.

On the 2nd day of the month Cpl. Gene Wright was assigned to the organization from the 29th Squadron per voice of the commanding officer and is to be the group barber.

The 7th of the month three men were ordered to the States after having spent nearly three years overseas. They were Technical Sergeants Curneil and deorge to go on the rotation plan and Sgt Jacobson to go on temporary duty for 30 days to the States (2).

Naster Sergeant Cardile was releived from assignment with the outfit and transfered to the 22nd Bomb Group (3).

Sgt Theeler was placed on flying status as an aerial photographer for the group (4).

Capt. Pryor left for home on the 10th after receiving orders from Bomber Command. He had been with the Group about 9 years (5).

Several other men were sade happy on the 12th by recaiving orders releasing them free this theater of operations and sending them back to the States either on rotation or a 30-day furlough. They were: Staff Sergeants Silverman and Delous were given the 30-days temporary duty to the Sates while Master Sergeant Finney, 3/Sgt Daughenbaugh and Sgt Villadsen went home on the rotation plan (1).

Two promotions in the medical department were granted on the 13th. Sergeant Doyers was promoted to Staff and Ffc. alford jumped to corporal per orders from the commanding officer (2).

On the 15th Sergeant Griffith was promoted to Staff (3). Two men were attached to the organization from V Domber Comman for duty. They were Fic. James Cunningham and Fic. Edward Schuler.

Due to a change in the T/C of the organization several men were transferred to other squafrons of the group and then placed on DS with headquarters. Nost of these men were out of the mesh hall, motor pool, communications and phote section. They were Cpl. Abeln, T/Sgt Briggs, 3/Sgt Neyn, Sgt Campeau, Sgt Catizone, Sgt Deely and 8/Sgt Gentry to the 90th Squadron; T/Sgt DeSerio, Cpl Finch, T/Sgt Bryant, Sgt See, Cpl Martin, Ffc Anderson and Fvt Melene to the 89th Squadron; Fvt Adkins and T/5 Baird to the 13th Squadron; Ffc Jaross, Cpl. Delunno, Sgt. Mack, T/Sgt. Anderson, S/Sgt. Molaberg, Sgt. Banach, Sgt. Bartels, Cpl. Bruckner, Cpl. Marrington, Ffc. McCaskey, Sgt Bahr, Sgt. Clae, Cpl. Diamond, Ffc. Nurse, Ffc. Lardiere and Ffc. The only two men out of headquarters to be granted furloughs to Australia for the month were Sgts Degovich and LoWerney. They went to Adelaide for 15 days.

On the 23rd the Group started to make preparations for moving to a new station on Mindoro Island, loading on the 25th on LSTs and departing on the 26th.

Col. Henebry was releived from assignment as commaning officer of the Group and assigned to FEAF CRTC at AFO 713 Unit 1. Lt. Col. Richard N. Ellis returned from the States and assumed command.

SECTION II

LOCAL INTEREST



The highlight of the month of December was the move from leyte Island to the Island of Findero just a little over a week after the invasion of the latter. Preparations for the move began on the 29rd and on the morning of Christmas day three LSTs beached near the Camp area and loading began in earnest. There was so much work to be done with the loading that the fact it was Christmas was forgotten but at noon the cooks had prepared turkey for the troops. The following morning the officers and enlisted was of headuanters boarded the LST carrying the 90th Squarron personnel and proceeded to look for a place to sleep for the tening three days.

It seems that the energy was still making an effort to harass our troops and shipping and raids had been carried out on the ships in the Tacloban harbor. Therefore, we were warned of the fact and lifebelts were issued to all the personnel. Buch of the enemy ait attacks upon our shipping was successful and results they obtained at Mindoro reached proportions that could hardly be dismissed as nuisance raids.

On the 28th of the month as our convoy was headed in the direction of Mindoro via the pass between Mindinao and Leyte Islands, past Cebu and Negros Islands, a total of 30 to 40 enemy planes in two attacks blew up an ammunition-laden Liberty ship, severely demaged another vessel on the same type and torpedoed one LST which was later sunk. Cur ships' ack ack shot down four aircraft which crash dived into the two Liberty ships mentioned above. Thile no further dwage was done to the codycy on the 20th, three enemy planes challenged it during the day, and another struck after dusk. As one Zero type plane started its long dive towards our LST all the guns of the LST opened up on it and after two bursts from the 40 millimeter gun the plane burst into flames and crashed into the sea between us and the LST on our side. After that several other planes were shot down by the various ships. F-61s put seven unfriendly fighters out of action forever, and maval ack ack shot down five more. For the third consecutive day, the enemy, throughout the 30th of December, attacked shipping after the convey had arrived at lincoro. Again resorting to crash dive tactics, four fighters blow up an aviation gas tanker, seriously damaged a Liberty ship and also damaged a FT tender. The men of the 3rd Group were very thankful that they arrived to their destination without mishap although several of them were quite nervous. The April 12, 1943 raid on Fort Moresby seemed like a 4th of July picnic compared to the raid we went through on this convey. All agreed that it was the worst they have been trough, yet. In all the convey shot down 23 enemy planes.

The morals of the Group in December was about as low as it could get. It seems the regime in charge of the group at the time couldn't stand to see the asmidle for a minute and so resorted to supervised recreation and drill. The afternoons were devided into two periods; the first half spent in infantry drill and the second half was spent in some type of sports. The drilling in itself wasn't so bad but when the Infantry troops and other GT's would pass by and shout at us and ask if we didn't know there was a war going on it made the men feel grite low. Then to top it all off, one afternoon an I-5 passed by and the pilot cut the engine and yelled out at us. This recruit stage kept on until the day we started to move.

Christmas was spent in loading the LST and very little time was had off to think about the meaning of the day. Turkey was served at dinner time to the majority of the men but a few missed out. Beer and digaretts were issued to the men the day before leaving Layte. Very few packages had been received from home and those that did get through were pretty wet and speiled.
