02-Jan-44	2-G-1	14 A-20	89	Saidor	Requested to attack target 3D by groundstation. Groundstation could not give appropriate ASP ref. Alternate target, track along Binding River, was bombed and strafed. Originally 15 planes - 1 A/C left area due to mechanical failure and landed at Finschhafen.
02-Jan-44	2-H-1	13 A-20	90	Saidor	Bombed and strafed area 910 Saidor. Originally target B9 - ASP coords given was "in ocean". Comment made: problem is mistake in use of maps - similar mistake made in mission 2 G-1 (89 Sqn)
03-Jan-44	3-A-1	12 A-20	8	Borgen Bay	Bombed and strafed enemy troop staging areas NE of Alaido Village.

07-Jan-44	7-I-1	12 A-20	89	Arawe	Bombed and strafed Amalut Plantation. 1 A-20 crashed on reef off Amalut Plantation. Crew seen in life raft heading for shore - all apparently safe. May have been brought down by "friendly" A/A fire. Several other A-20's were holed by friendly A/A fire.

10-Jan-44	10-I-1	12 A-20G	89	Sio Area	Bombed and strafed targets at (1) Nambariwa River mouth, (2) area 650 yds West and 300 yds inland at Sio Mission and (3) area 1 mile West of Sio Mission.
12-Jan-44	12-B-1	12 A-20G	90	Madang	Bombed and strafed enemy stores approx 3 miles west of Cape Iris (Warai Village).
13-Jan-44	13-C-1	10 A-20G	8	Bogadjim Road	Bombed and strafed targets of opportunity along Bogadjim Road between coast and bridge no 12. 12 A/C took off but 2 returned to base before reaching target due to mechanical trouble.
13-Jan-44	13-C-1	12 A-20G	89	Bogadjim Road	Bombed and strafed targets along the Bogadjim to Bridge No 23.
13-Jan-44	13-I-1	10 A-20G	90	Arawe	Bombed and strafed dumps and troops near Didmop Village.

20-Jan-44	20-B-1	12 A-20G	8	New Britain	Hit targets of opportunity at Pulie River, Rein Bay and west of Cape Raoult from minimum altitude.
21-Jan-44	21-B-1	13 A-20G	89	Roinji Village	Bombed and strafed Roinji Village at minimum altitude. Primary target. INDAGEN, was not attacked due to cloud cover. Approx 12 parachutes were seen at Lepsuis Pt about 1 mile from shore. One supply parachute seen at Weber Pt near wrecked airplane.
21-Jan-44	21-D-1	12 A-20	8	Gali Village	Bombed and strafed Gali Village and track along the coast for 1 mile either side of village. Many small parachutes seen on Weber Pt
22-Jan-44	22-M-1	12 A-20	89	Iboki Plantation	Bombed and strafed Iboki Plantation at minimum altitude. Primary target, shipping at Kokopo was not bomber due to nil targets.
23-Jan-44	23-L-1	13 A-20	89	Natamo Point	Bombed and strafed pillboxes at minimum altitude.
23-Jan-44	23-K-1	10 A-20	13	Bonga Village	Bombed and strafed Bonga Village at minimum altitude. One A/C returned to base before reaching target due to mechanical trouble.
24-Jan-44	24-K-1	1 A-20	89	New Britain	Supply dropping mission
26-Jan-44	26-J-1	34 A-20	8, 13 & 89	Madang	34 A-20 (12 from 8th Sqn, 10 from 13th Sqn and 12 from 89th Sqn) bombed and strafed troops and supplies at Gali, Old Yagomai, Bongi and Yara Villages at minimum altitude. One plane hit by 22mm or 50 cal shells from Old Yagomai.
26-Jan-44	26-M-1	8 A-20G	13	Natamo	Bombed and strafed troops inland from river mouth and 1000 yards SE of Natamo.
27-Jan-44	27-G-1	23 A-20	8 & 89	Madang area	Bombed and strafed targets at Amelet Mission (89th Sqn) and Nobanob Village (8th Sqn). An unidentified aircraft was seen to blow up and crash between Jacob Is and Madang at 0910 hours.
27-Jan-44	27-G-1	9 A-20	13	Madang area	Unable to complete mission to Amron Village. Turned back due to bad weather in vicinity of Ramu River
28-Jan-44	28-I-1	12 A-20	8	Borgen Bay	Bombed and strafed troops along east side of the palm grove on east side of Borgen Bay
28-Jan-44	28-H-1	9 A-20	13	Singor-Dagur	Bombed and strafed troops at Singor and Dagur at minimum altitude. One airplane returned to base before reaching target due to mechanical trouble.
29-Jan-44	29-I-1	9 A-20	13	Natamo	Bombed and strafed enemy defense positions east and south of Natamo River mouth
29-Jan-44	29-G-1	36 A-20	8, 89 & 90	Cape Bushing area	Bombed and strafed enemy supply and personnel areas in Cape Bushing area at minimum altitude.
